Wally spoke and gave thanks for award he received. He indicated more training classes will be forthcoming. He received a call from the Deputy Chief of St. Louis FD regarding sprinkler saves. In all, there were 3 sprinkler saves in the city of St. Louis, 2 sprinkler saves in Wentzville and 1 in O'Fallon. He indicated the organization has contacted the news media but they treat it as a non-story. The Alliance has donated \$500.00 to Backstoppers.

New Business:

Roger Herin brought up the by-laws committee will be meeting in January and will be considering extensive changes to the by-laws and how they relate to the Fire Chief's organization.

Steve stated the state fire marshals had purchased a laptop computer and recommended this organization consider purchasing a laptop for the secretary and treasurer. A motion to this effect was made by Steve and seconded, motion carried.

After some discussion, Wally stated his organization would donate a laptop computer to this organization. There was then discussion on whether the motion made by Steve should stand and the organization obtain two computers, one for the secretary and one for the treasurer. Dave Nichols motioned to go ahead and pursue purchasing a laptop in addition to the one being donated. Motion was seconded and motion carried. Marc Ulises stated he has a laptop he might be able to use for his duties as treasurer.

Art Oestereich stated the Creve Coeur Fire District approved an ordinance requiring UL certification for alarm systems at new and remodeled locations in the district. If an existing system has four false alarms in one month, that system will then be required to be upgraded and certified by UL. Art indicated he would be willing to share Creve Coeur's model ordinance with other fire departments and districts. It was brought up that UL has sample model ordinances as well.

Bill Fox indicated an existing multi-family building in the city of Shrewsbury which had a fire was now fully sprinklered, with assistance from the fire sprinkler alliance organization.

Steve inquired as to whether the organizations funds were in an interest bearing account. Paul stated they were not. Steve suggested some of the funds could be deposited in interest bearing certificates of deposit. Paul stated the account stays between \$6,000.00-7,000.00 and sometimes a large portion of the account needs to be used for up-front seminar or conference expenses and is then replaced upon receipt of registrations, etc. Bill indicated the organization can have a "review" of the finances but not a full audit. The officers agreed this might be a good idea and will look into it.

Dan with the sprinkler fitters thanked the organization for the work we do in enforcing the fire and building codes and offered any assistance he or his organization might be able to give. Dan spoke of the problem with out-of-town sprinkler fitters and the poor workmanship that might result with their use by a general contractor and the dangers of sprinklers not being installed properly. He asked for information on who to contact in each municipality/district regarding the Authority Having Jurisdiction to pass on to the contractors. Anthony with the AGC agreed and requested the same information.
