**Communications:**

HBA letters sent to municipal politicians regarding sprinklers. The letters had a negative tone regarding residential sprinklers, and questionable sprinkler cost information. There was much discussion including (but not limited to): The HBA seems to be going back on their word that they would help promote residential sprinklers if the agreement between them and the FSA was signed; SB7 did not pass but HB103 did (HB103 had same sprinkler language as SB7); Missouri American Water is still an obstacle that needs to be dealt with regarding the residential sprinkler issue.

The Funeral Assistance Team submitted a request for a donation. The membership voted to pay for a ceremonial pike pole sponsorship in the amount of \$300.00.

**Committee Reports:**

**Fire Chiefs:** John LaVenture – John presented the minutes of the April 14, 2009 Fire Chief's meeting. Items of note were: Bob Young is retiring from St. Louis County Police; a legislative report was given; they need an education committee; the awards program will be October 18, 2009 at Kirkwood Community Center.

**Education Committee:** Steve Gettemeier or John LaVenture – We need to work on PSAs for the sprinkler issue; we also need to work on more sprinkler demonstrations.

**State Fire Marshals:** Roger Herin – Had a meeting April 15, 2009. Legislative issues were discussed; conference will be August 3, 4 & 5 at Tan-Tar-A – hotel reservations are being accepted, info and registration form will be on the website ([www.fmamonline.com](http://www.fmamonline.com)) soon.

**ICC:** Paul Mercurio – There was a “meet-and-greet” with Bob Neale last week for chapter leaders. **St. Louis Sprinkler Alliance:** Wally Miller – On April 11, 2009 there was a dedication of the rebuilt fraternity house where a 13R sprinkler system was donated after a fatal fire. **Code Review:** Paul Mercurio – Paul stated that the St. Louis County code review committees are meeting regularly now, and that anyone can attend the meetings. Go to the County website for meeting dates and times. All are encouraged to attend and have an impact on the County code adoption process. Paul is on the Mechanical review committee, and they are up to Chapter 3 so far – fire/smoke dampers are defined in the new code.

#### **Old Business:**

**By-Laws:** Roger Herin – Proposed changes were handed out and will be emailed to the membership at least 10 days prior to the next meeting at which time they will be voted on. Roger briefly went over the changes.

#### **New Business:**

**Recognition of Past Service:** Jerry Ambrossecchia was honored for his past service to the Association – particularly for serving 8 years as President – with a plaque. After his acceptance, a motion was made, seconded and approved to award Jerry a Lifetime Honorary Membership.

**Proposed Code Change for St. Louis County:** Roger Herin presented a proposed a code change for member consideration to sponsor at the St. Louis County Building Code Review Committee. The code change deals with protecting the bottom of floors built of lightweight construction. The membership voted to sponsor the code change proposal.

Tom Presnak stated that UL will have a booth at the NFPA conference in Chicago and encouraged all to stop by. He also introduced James Knapp.

Steve Gettemeier stated he has found that KFC has installed grills in all their restaurants. In most (if not all), they have changed the cook line such that the suppression system is not covering the cooking equipment, and the cooking equipment may not be located properly under the hood.

All jurisdictions should be checking to see that all appropriate NFPA test certificates for fire protection systems are submitted.
