Committee Reports:

Fire Chiefs: John LaVenture – Awards ceremony was discussed – it will be Sunday, 18, 1:00 PM at Kirkwood Community Center. Roger Herin and Marc Ulises attended a meeting with the GSLFCA officers regarding finances of all organizations under the GSLFCA umbrella. Several members of the Chiefs questioned whether MFMA needs to be under the umbrella. The Chiefs will discuss it and vote on it. It may come to a MFMA vote in November.

Education Committee: Steve Gettemeier or John LaVenture – Dan Flynn brought up a firestopping class sponsored by Jefferson County Fire Marshals.

State Fire Marshals: Roger Herin – No report – their meeting is today also.

State ICC Chapter: Paul Richards – No report.

MABOI: Bryan Kopp – No Report.

ICC: Ed Berkel – Today is the deadline to register for the code hearings in Baltimore.

Jefferson County Fire Marshals Assoc.: Lloyd Montgomery – They will have training tomorrow (Oct. 15).

St. Louis Sprinkler Alliance: Wally Miller – There were two local sprinkler saves recently – one at Pattonville School District, and one at the Centre on Conway. Both were thought to have been arson.

Code Review: Steve Gettemeier or John LaVenture – MABOI is up to reviewing the IRC.

BCRC: Roger Herin – The BCRC is up to Chapter 3 in the IRC. They want to know if any of the jurisdictions represented have any problems with wireless technology or combination smoke/CO detectors. None of the members present had such problems, and will recognize these technologies as long as they comply with NFPA72.

MCRC: Paul Mercurio – Paul stated that there was not much going on.

Old Business:

By-Laws: Roger Herin – To be voted on in November.

New Business: Paul Mercurio talked about a meeting with HBA, Missouri American Water and several regional fire authorities regarding water supplies for residential sprinkler systems. Paul handed out existing and proposed rules for the water supplies, which were discussed at length.

Paul then handed out samples of the Proposition E-911 information literature. Discussion ensued.

Paul then announced the new “Forms” section of the website, and encouraged everyone to submit forms that are used for code enforcement so we can ultimately come up with more uniform forms and code enforcement.

Roundtable: Tony Simpson initiated discussion regarding triage tents for H1N1 flue. Tony encouraged a uniformed approach to this if needed in different jurisdictions.

Anthony Lancia announced that the Permit Locator website is up and running, and encouraged anyone not participating to join.

Good of the Order: Dan Flynn stated that Shriner's Hospital security is still in need of hand-held radios – if your department has surplus radios, please donate them.
